## **Questar Announces Senior-Management Retirements, Appointments**

SALT LAKE CITY — Questar Corp. (NYSE:STR) today announced retirements and appointments in its senior-management team.

Connie C. Holbrook, senior vice president, corporate general counsel and corporate secretary, and Glenn H. Robinson, vice president and chief information officer, will retire effective April 30. Holbrook and Robinson joined a Questar predecessor company in 1974 and 1977, respectively.

Questar Chairman and CEO Keith Rattie said: “Questar’s Board of Directors and I thank Connie and Glenn for their significant contributions to the company.

“Connie has been an officer for more than 20 years. Over the past decade, she has served simultaneously as general counsel, vice president of Human Resources and corporate secretary. In essence, she’s been the chief of staff to three Questar CEOs, three generations of senior management, and the Board for over two decades. Her work ethic is legendary within this company, as is her unswerving commitment to protecting Questar’s reputation for integrity.

“Glenn has helped senior management and the Board reshape the corporation’s strategic direction with his vision and planning and analytical skills. In recent years he has served as chief

information officer, where he has ensured that Questar business units get maximum bang for the buck from information-technology expenditures.”

Thomas C. Jepperson will become corporate vice president and general counsel effective April 1. He currently serves as division counsel for Questar Market Resources (QMR), a subsidiary that conducts gas and oil exploration and production and other nonregulated activities.

Abigail L. Jones will become corporate secretary and report to Jepperson effective April 1. She will also retain her title of senior attorney. Jones currently serves as assistant corporate secretary and senior attorney.

Diane Q. Mansfield has been named vice president, Human Resources, also effective April 1. She will report to Rattie on human-resources issues and policy and to Jepperson for corporate compliance, benefit planning and compensation. Mansfield currently is director, Human Resources.

Jay B. Neese has been promoted to executive vice president of QMR and its subsidiaries, effective immediately. He previously served as vice president of Questar Exploration and Production, a QMR subsidiary. He will continue to report to Charles B. Stanley, QMR president and CEO and Questar executive vice president.

Eric L. Dady, currently QMR senior attorney, has been named QMR general counsel effective April 1 and will report to Stanley.

Questar is a natural gas-focused energy company with \$5.3 billion in enterprise value. Headquartered in Salt Lake City, Questar engages in gas and oil development and production; gas gathering, processing and marketing; interstate gas transmission and storage; and retail gas distribution.
