Duties and Responsibilities

Successful candidate will be responsible to lead, develop and implement processes and procedures to insure measurement data quality control. Candidate must be able to identify and reconcile volume discrepancies. Ensure safe work practices are an integral part of the measurement team's work performance. Be responsible to maintain up to date meter-proving schedule with witness notification in compliance with contracts.

Work Conditions

Requires: frequent standing, driving a four-wheel drive vehicle, and occasional bending, squatting, climbing, twisting, balancing and reaching. Individual will be required to work in extreme temperature conditions, both hot and cold; in and/or around moisture; on slippery and/or uneven surfaces, in confined spaces; and at heights. Will be exposed to: noise, vibration, salt water, chemical substances (i.e., well-treating chemicals, glycol, ambitol, methanol, solvents, gasoline, natural gas and liquid hydrocarbons). The successful candidate will be working a 9/80 work schedule. Additional hours and call-outs are an essential part of the business.

Minimum Qualifications

- **Knowledge of:** gas production equipment, pressure isolation and control, electrical and instrument systems and controls; various test and calibration instruments; governmental safety and environmental regulations; proficiency with Microsoft Office programs and calibration programs which operate in both the Windows and DOS environments; company standard practices, emergency plan, operating inspection, maintenance plan and all safety requirements.
- **Skill in:** basic arithmetic and oral and written communications.
- **Ability to:** lift items weighing up to 75 pounds; move items weighing up to 500 pounds with equipment assistance; use various hand tools; hear; see objects at close range and in the distance; distinguish colors and relationship between objects; read and understand technical documents, understand and complete written and oral instructions; be courteous to co-workers and customers; follow directions from supervisors; and refrain from abusive or profane language and behavior in the workplace.
- **Requirements:** Must possess a valid driver's license; an acceptable driving record; have good vision to inspect equipment condition and recognize hazardous conditions; good hearing to be able to detect hazardous conditions; regular attendance; and must adhere to all company policies, including the Questar Corporation Business Ethics and Compliance Policy. Position will require travel in both on- and off-road conditions; must have the ability to respond to emergency conditions which may include: changing flat tires, chaining up vehicle, operating jacks and performing minor maintenance.
