Duties and Responsibilities

Responsible for the service, maintenance and repair of compressors, engines, generators and pumps. Perform maintenance and major mechanical overhauls with minimal supervision. Verify dimensions, specifications and tolerances per manufacturer's specifications. Understand and be able to troubleshoot engine and compressor support equipment (i.e., air fuel ratio systems, electronic ignition, compressor panels) and be abreast of current technology. Maintain compressor spare parts inventory. Perform other duties as assigned.

Work Conditions

Requires: frequent standing; occasional bending, squatting, climbing, twisting, balancing and reaching; and use of a four-wheel-drive vehicle. Requires working: rotating schedules; on call; irregular or extended work hours; in extreme weather conditions (hot and cold); in or around moisture; on slippery and/or uneven surfaces; in confined spaces; at heights; and around noise, vibration and moving objects. May be exposed to: nonionizing radiation; salt water; and chemical substances such as well-treating chemicals, glycol, ambitol, methanol, solvents, gasoline, natural gas and liquid hydrocarbons.

Minimum Qualifications

- **Knowledge of:** natural gas engines, compressors, generators and pumps; company standard practices; emergency plan; operating inspection, maintenance plan; and all safety requirements.
- **Skill in:** basic math, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; and following written and oral instructions.
- **Ability to:** lift items weighing up to 75 pounds; move items weighing up to 500 pounds with equipment assistance; use various hand tools and hoists; hear; see objects at close range and in the distance; distinguish colors and relationship between objects; understand and complete oral and written instructions; communicate effectively orally and in writing; receive and convey information; be courteous to co-workers and customers; follow directions from supervisors; and refrain from abusive or profane language and behavior in the workplace.
- **Requirements:** A minimum of one year experience as a mechanic on a variety of equipment related to the natural gas industry (i.e., compressors, engines, etc.); a valid driver's license; an acceptable driving record; obtain and maintain medical clearance to operate DOT-regulated vehicle; must adhere to all policies established by the company, including the Questar Corporation Business Ethics and Compliance Policy; and regular attendance.
