Duties and Responsibilities

Within the boundary of the Uinta Basin Division's overall business processes, provide leadership and cost effective project management for a portfolio of oil and gas assets in the Uinta Basin of Northeastern Utah. Working with the division technical professionals, coordinate, prioritize, plan, and execute projects that improve operational efficiencies and maximize oil/gas production volumes. Actively participate with all division groups in the development of field operations strategy and facility design activities. Become an integral member of the Uinta Basin Division management team and willingly accept accountability for division performance parameters (safety, environmental compliance, mentoring employees, production and lease operating expense goals, teamwork, open and honest communication). Lead an operations team tasked with identifying and initiating cost-effective projects for revenue enhancement with production increases or lease operating expense reductions. Project scopes will include risk analysis, engineering design, process optimization, AFE generation, economic analysis, procurement, hazard analysis, contractor supervision and facility startup operations. Identify, understand, and comply with applicable laws, regulations and permitting requirements on state, federal and tribal lands, and work to minimize their impacts on Questar operations. Foster communication between the accounting, land, geology, and drilling departments to optimize key business processes and drive continuous improvement efforts throughout the division. Miscellaneous technical analyses and data requests to assist the Uinta Basin general manager. Select and supervise contract engineering resources. Directly supervise employee field superintendent, operations engineers, completions foreman and engineering technician. Support the division and corporate goals. Analyses of significant variances of division production and expense performance relative to goals; and perform other duties as assigned.

Work Conditions

Requires: working in a team environment; occasional, irregular, additional and weekend work hours for project completion.
