Duties and Responsibilities

Perform installation and maintenance of electrical, instrumentation and automation systems associated with automated wellhead operations, natural gas processing plants, compression facilities, production equipment and liquid pumping stations; compliance and enforcement of company, safety, environmental, governmental policies and regulations as they apply; performing other duties as assigned.

Work Conditions

Requires: Working in a team oriented environment; working under stressful conditions associated with critical project deadlines and heavy workloads; supervision; will be required to work in extreme temperature conditions, both hot and cold; in and/or around moisture, on slippery and/or uneven surfaces, in confined spaces, and at heights; will require frequent standing, driving a 4-wheel drive vehicle, and occasional bending, squatting, climbing, twisting, balancing, and reaching; will have exposure to noise, vibrations, well-treating chemicals, glycol, methanol, gasoline, natural gas, and liquid hydrocarbons; may require irregular or extended hours and travel for project completion.

Minimum Qualifications

- **Knowledge** of: AC and DC electrical theory, basic trouble shooting techniques and electrical construction techniques; voltage/current measurement techniques a basic understanding of the National Electrical code.
- **Skill** in: The use of various power tools including conduit bending and threading equipment; basic computer skills using Excel & MS Word and the use of various hand tools.
- **Ability** to: work independently and within a team atmosphere, take direction and follow through, adapt to new ideas/technology; basic understanding of electrical prints or wiring diagrams cooperatively interact with customers, government agencies, sales representatives, engineers; work with contractors to complete work assignments; communicate orally and in writing; be courteous to co-workers and customers; follow directions from supervisors; lift items weighing up to 75 lb.; hear; see objects at close range and in the distance; distinguish colors and relationship between objects; and refrain from abusive or profane language and behavior in the workplace.
- **Requirements:** The apprentice job family contains four levels: each requiring notarized documentation to certify completed hours in craft and schooling: the requirements are:

Fourth Year Apprentice, requires 6000 hours in craft and 432 in schooling, completed.

Third Year Apprentice, requires 4000 hours in craft and 288 in schooling, completed.

Second Year Apprentice requires 2000 hours in craft and 144 in schooling, completed.
First Year Apprentice is for the beginner and requires minimal experience.

This position requires a minimum experience level equal to a second year apprentice.

A valid "Journeyman or Master Electrician" license is preferred. Automation and instrument experience and/or oil and gas experience are also preferred; possess valid driver's license; regular attendance and must adhere to all company policies including the Questar Corporation Business Ethics and Compliance Policy.
