Duties and Responsibilities

To operate and maintain the Pinedale Compressor Station & Liquids Stabilization Plant. Duties will involve working with the inlet liquids separation, overhead gas compression, condensate liquids stabilization system, storage and shipping gas liquids, heat medium system, reboilers, heat exchangers, used water and oil tanks, split loads on compressors, understanding and using pneumatic controllers, natural gas engines and compressors, condensate pipeline liquids pumps, plant programmable logic controllers, flow measurement, gas sampling and chromatography equipment. Monitor pressures, temperatures, flows, and liquid levels. Prepare daily and monthly reports and perform minor maintenance. Computer skills to include but not limited to: word processor, spreadsheet, data entry, and process variable adjustment at PLC controlled process units.

Work Conditions

Requires: frequent standing, driving a 4-wheel drive vehicle, and occasional bending, squatting, climbing, twisting, balancing, and reaching. Individual will be required to work in extreme temperature conditions, both hot and cold; in and/or around moisture; on slippery and/or uneven surfaces, in confined spaces; and at heights. Will be exposed to: noise; vibrations; nonionizing radiation; salt water; chemical substances (i.e., well-treating chemicals, glycol, ambitrol, methanol, solvents, gasoline, natural gas, and liquid hydrocarbons) Will work rotating 12 hour shift schedule.

Minimum Qualifications

- **Knowledge of:** company standard practices, emergency plan, operating inspection, maintenance plan and all safety requirements; gas compression, water and oil tanks, natural gas engines and compressors, plant computer and control equipment.
- **Skill in:** basic arithmetic and oral and written communications. Computer skills using Excel & Word.
- **Ability to:** lift items weighing up to 75 lb.; move items weighing up to 500 lb. with equipment assistance; use various hand tools and hoists; hear; see objects at close range and in the distance; distinguish colors and relationship between objects; understand and complete oral and written instructions; communicate effectively orally and in writing; receive and convey information; be courteous to co-workers and customers; follow directions from supervisors; and refrain from abusive or profane language and behavior in the workplace.
