QUESTAR APPOINTS MCKEE TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS

SALT LAKE CITY — Questar Corp. (STR) today announced the appointment of R.E. “Rob” McKee III, former executive vice president of ConocoPhillips, to its 13-member Board of Directors.

“Rob McKee brings to our Board broad experience with the gas and oil exploration and production business as we continue to expand this growing part of our integrated natural gas activities,” said Keith O. Rattie, Questar president and CEO.

McKee retired from ConocoPhillips on Mar. 31, 2003. He was executive vice president, exploration and production, for Conoco Inc. from 1996 until the company merged with Phillips in 2002, when he became executive vice president. He previously held several other senior positions with Conoco, including vice president, refining and marketing, North America; senior vice president, administration; and executive vice president, corporate strategy and business development.

McKee is on the boards of directors of the American Petroleum Institute and the National U.S.-Arab Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Society of Petroleum Engineers, and chairman of the U.S.-Russia Business Council’s energy committee. He is past chairman of the Southern Regional Advisory Board of the Institute of International Education and a member of the advisory committee of the University of Texas Engineering Department.

McKee received a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering from the Colorado School of Mines and a master's degree in industrial management from MIT. In 1992, he was honored by the board of trustees of the Colorado School of Mines in recognition of distinguished career achievements.

McKee will complete the term of Scott S. Parker, who resigned in 2002 to pursue private interests. The term expires in 2004.

Questar is a \$3.1 billion diversified natural gas company headquartered in Salt Lake City. Through subsidiaries, it engages in gas and oil development and production; gas gathering, processing and marketing; interstate gas transmission and storage; retail gas distribution; retail energy services; and information systems and technologies.
