Questar Gas requests rate increase

SALT LAKE CITY — Questar Gas today asked the Wyoming Public Service Commission (PSC) to approve a \$1,361,000 increase in its natural gas rates. If approved, this change will go into effect June 1, 2004.

The increase results from higher projected purchased-gas prices. Questar purchases about half of the gas it provides customers from outside suppliers. The rest comes from Questar Gas-owned reserves that are delivered to customers at “cost-of-service” pricing. This company-owned gas is currently significantly less expensive than gas purchased from outside suppliers.

If this request is approved by the PSC, it will increase the monthly bill for the typical residential customer about five percent. This change, combined with previous pass-on changes during the last 12 months, will result in the typical customer paying about the same for gas as last summer, based on the same usage.

The increase request is part of the company’s regular gas-cost-adjustment “pass-on” filing. Such filings have no effect on the company’s net income. They simply enable the company to change rates to reflect changes in gas-supply costs. Questar Gas typically applies to the PSC for rate changes every six months.
