Questar Appoints M.W. Scoggins to Board of Directors

SALT LAKE CITY — Questar Corp. (NYSE:STR) announced today that Myles W. Scoggins has been appointed to the Questar Corp. Board of Directors, filling a seat left vacant by the retirement of long-time director W.W. Hawkins.

Scoggins, 57, retired in 2004 after a 34-year career with Mobil Corp. and Exxon Mobil Corp., where he held senior executive positions in the upstream oil and gas business. From 2001 to 2004 he served as executive vice president of Exxon Mobil Production Co. Prior to the merger of Mobil and Exxon in late 1999, he was president, International E&P and Global Exploration, and an officer and member of the executive committee of Mobil Oil Corp.

“Bill Scoggins is a superb addition to an already strong board,” said Keith Rattie, Questar chairman and CEO. “With Bill’s appointment, four of the 10 independent directors have extensive E&P backgrounds. In short, we’ve aligned board experience with our corporate strategy to grow our unregulated businesses.”

Scoggins holds a doctorate in petroleum engineering from the University of Tulsa. He and his wife, Karen, reside in Houston, and have three sons.

Questar is a natural gas-focused energy company with \$5.3 billion in enterprise value. Headquartered in Salt Lake City, Questar engages in gas and oil development and production; gas gathering, processing and marketing; interstate gas transmission and storage; and retail gas distribution.
